Be sure that the topic sentence of your first paragraph uses key words from the question.

1. In what ways does *FIGHT CLUB* fulfill the characteristics of a Film Noir (be specific)?
2. What is the first rule of FIGHT CLUB?
3. What is the second rule of FIGHT CLUB?
4. What is the significance of the fact that the Narrator/Jack's real name is never revealed?
5. What are the men in fight club looking for? Why are they unable to find it in their day to day lives?
6. Choose one major symbol in the film and analyze its significance for the meaning of the film: sleeplessness, violence, soap, identity, freedom, anarchy, fat, scars, Robert Paulson, iKEA, materialism

7. What did you think of the film? What specifically did you like or not like about it? Are you Tyler Durden?

8. What is one filmmaking technique that you especially liked from watching this movie, and what would you want to learn how to replicate from this film in your own projects?
